Gospel of Mark: Choice Board

As we read the Gospel of Mark, we will stop occasionally to critically reflect on and respond to the stories we've discussed. Below, a choice board reflects some creative options for you to dwell in the Word of God.

There will be about 6-8 opportunities for this type of reflection in total. Each type of choice can be used for a maximum of two times (ie. you may end up only using 3-4 of the choices).

My hope is that this type of reflection will help to consolidate our understanding of the Gospel of Mark while allowing for students to connect with the Scripture in a way that speaks to them most.
