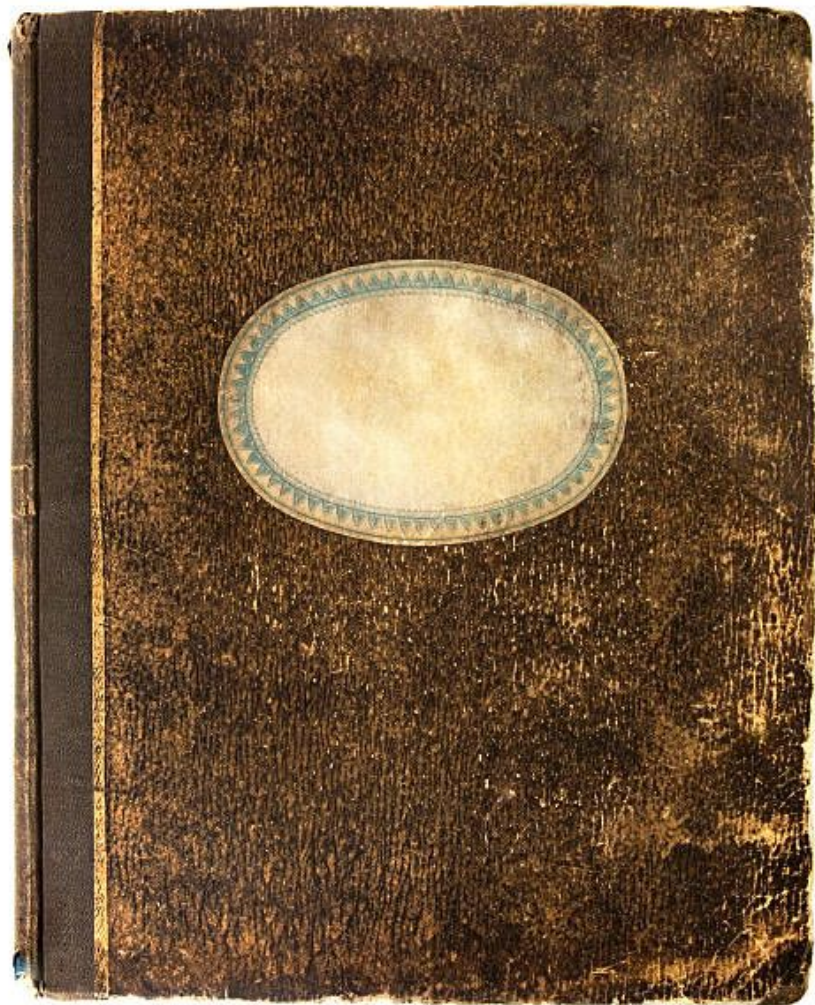

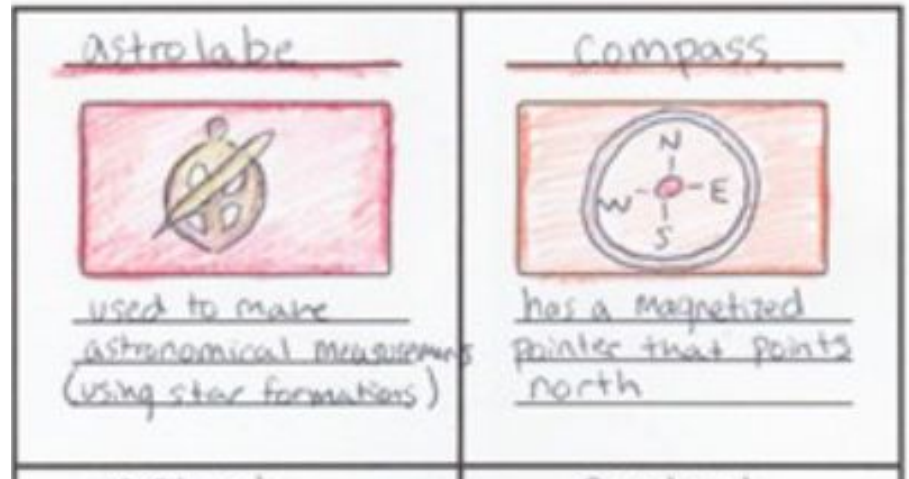
A Brief Biography

- Draw at least one of your explorer's voyages on a world map
- Label the involved oceans, countries, and cities



Journal Entries

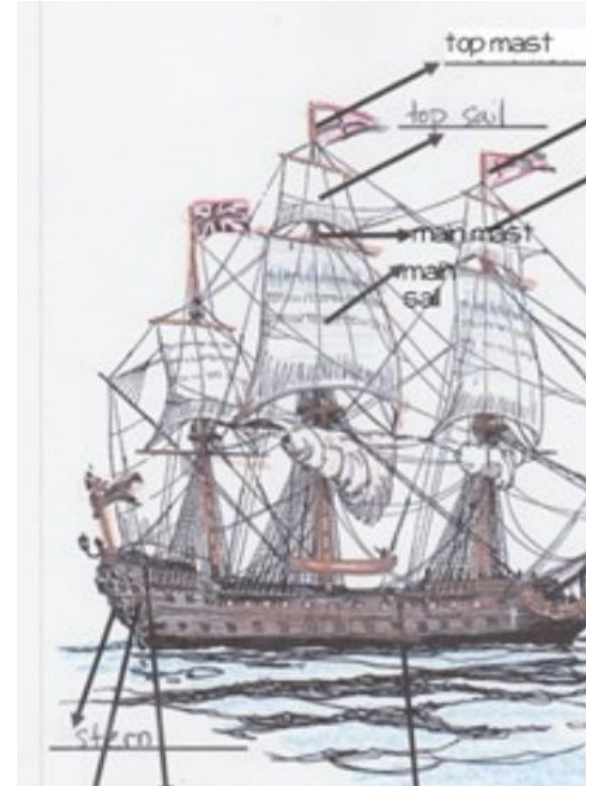
(/ 10)

 - Returning back home?
- Aim for ½ page each
- Include relevant details from their voyages

Design a Sailing Ship

(/ 15)

- Conduct research on sailing ships from the 1500s (look up “caravels” and “carracks”)
- Based on your research, name and design a ship that includes at least five features (parts) that are similar to early ships
- Build a 3D model of your ship or create a **detailed** and labeled sketch
